Communication skills are learned through practice and play while the children are often exposed to situations through which drama teaches them empathy.


We focus on the acting, physical, vocal, and other techniques which improve the student's theatrical skills.

#### **CODING CLUB**



#### **ROBOTICS**


Recent studies suggest that robots could take over many jobs currently done by humans.
